

## CARDBOARD WASTE BINS

Solo provide CARDBOARD waste bins in 2 sizes:

- 1.1 cubic metres
- 1.5 cubic metres



**How does the service work?**

Solo can advise you on which size bin to select and how often to have it serviced. Once you choose a bin size and frequency of service, whether it be regular or 'on call,' Solo will deliver your bin to your premises or property.

The collection vehicle will visit on the days you have chosen to empty the bin. The cardboard is taken to an EPA (Environment Protection Agency) approved recycling facility.

**What can I put in the bin?**

In the cardboard bins you can load any cardboard or paper products. Please do not deposit garbage items such as food waste, building materials or general waste.

Waste, office, workshop, retail store, warehouse and food outlet cardboard are all OK. Staples, tape and clips will be removed in the recycling process.

**What about wheels and lids?**

Bins are available with wheels for moving to and from the collection location. Metal or lighter plastic lids are available. Locks are an option for increased security. Galvanised bins are available for areas close to the coastline.

**The history of paper and cardboard....**

The Chinese invented paper in about the year 105 AD. It wasn't until about 1600 years later that they also invented cardboard. The English then invented the first commercial cardboard box in 1817. The 1850's saw the introduction of corrugated cardboard and then an accident in American, Robert Gair's paper bag plant saw the invention of flexible cardboard, which enabled the production of cardboard boxes that could be flat stacked, a turning point for packaging and freight worldwide.
