

## WHEELIE BINS

Solo provide WHEELIE BINS for the following uses:

Commercial waste - 240 litre (0.24 cubic metres)

Domestic waste - 240 litre

Domestic garden waste - 240 litre



**How does the service work?**

Solo can advise you on how often you should have your bin serviced. Once you select a bin type (garbage or garden waste) and frequency of service, whether it be regular or "On call", Solo will deliver your bin to your premises or property.

The collection vehicle will visit on the days you have chosen to empty the bin. The waste is taken to an EPA (Environment Protection Agency) approved disposal site.

**What can I put in the bin?**

If you have a garbage wheelie bin you can deposit household or commercial waste excluding gas bottles, hazardous materials, soil, rubble, concrete, paint, oil, tyres or heavy or large items. If you have a garden waste bin you can deposit leaves, prunings, small branches and logs and lawn clippings but no garbage, treated timber, large logs or food.

**Where do I put the bin for collection?**

Simply place your bin at the kerbside, leaving 1 metre between the bin and any trees, parked cars or power poles. The wheels of the bin should face away from the kerb and please ensure that the lid is fully closed.
